Note:

1. Demand draft should be made in favor of “Alliance University School of Law” payable at Bangalore.
2. All costs associated with the International Exchange Programs such as travel, boarding, lodging, insurance, tuition fee (if applicable), and related expenses will be additional and shall be borne by the student.
3. NRI fee is applicable for the full duration of the course for candidates who have pursued and completed their last qualifying exam from outside India and for candidates who have applied under NRI Category.
4. No application for refund will be entertained once the candidate has completed the process of admission.
5. All students are required to pay a refundable caution deposit of INR 10,000/- along with the first installment of tuition fees.
6. All students are required to pay INR 3,000/- towards the membership of Alliance Alumni Association and INR 1,500/- towards the convocation fees along with the first installment of tuition fees.
7. The minimum period of submission of Ph. D. Thesis is three years including the course work
8. An extension on two years is granted to the students (if required) on approval by the Honorable Chancellor.
9. An additional fees of INR 20,000/- must be paid if the student is availing the extension in the course duration.
10. Full-time faculty and staff of Alliance University are eligible for a 50% scholarship on the tuition fee.
